

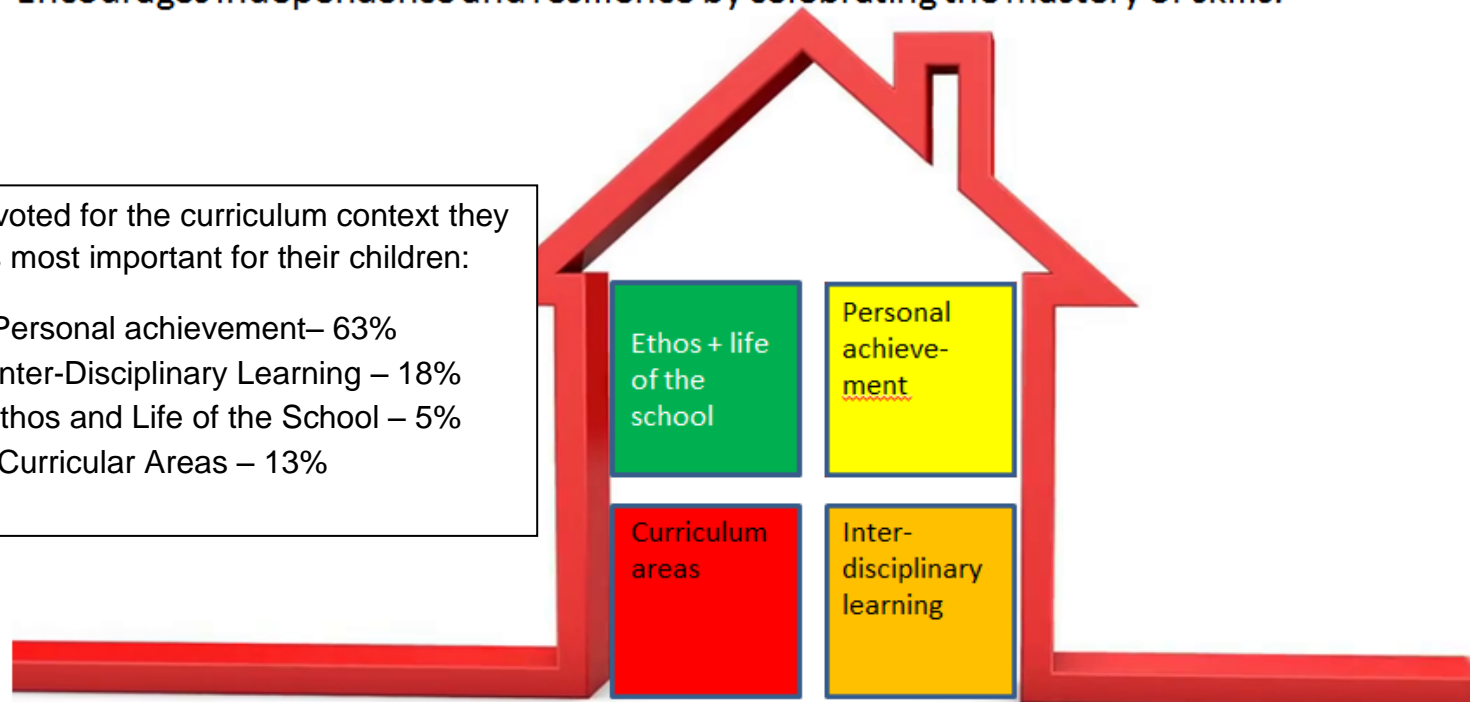


In the Westpark family, our curriculum:
